Class 9. First Ridden Rider 12yrs and under, pony not to exceed 13.2hh ^ -Equifest

Class 10. Ridden Novice Walk and Trot Genuine Novice Horse or Riders please, not open to lead reins 9 and under, novice older riders can be assisted and will be judged accordingly. Snaffle bridles only. This is a walk and trot class to aid confidence, please enter in the spirit it is intended. No members points are awarded for this class. ^

Class 11. Open Mountain and Moorland not open to lead-rein ^ -Equifest

Class 12. Riding Club Pony or Horse There will be a small fence to jump for the riding club pony/horse, snaffle bridles only. ^

Class 13. Open Pony 14.2hh and under -Equifest

Class 14. Open Horse over 14.2hh -Equifest

Class 15. Ridden Veteran Horse or pony 15yrs of age or over ^

Class 16. Ridden Coloured Includes Dun, Palomino, Roan & Spotted ^ -Equifest

**Appendix 2 Lead-Rein showing, ponies not to exceed 127cm (12.2) to gain qualification. All other lead-rein riders must be mounted on a suitable height pony – committee authorised.
