- Class 7. Coloured Including Palomino, Dun, Roan & Spotted ^ -Equifest


In-Hand Championship 1st & 2nd Placed competitors from classes 1-7 go forward to Championship.

Ring 1 - Ridden Showing Commencing after In Hand Championship, not before 11:30am

- Class 8. Lead-Rein 9 years & under. Snaffle bridles only. **Appendix 2 ^ -Equifest
- Class 9. First Ridden Rider 12yrs and under, pony not to exceed 13.2hh ^ -Equifest
- Class 10. Style and Appearance Open to all Competitors will be asked to complete a show piece.
- Class 11. Open Mountain and Moorland not open to lead-rein ^ -Equifest
- Class 12. Open Pony or Horse Equifest
- Class 13. Ridden Veteran Horse or pony 15yrs of age or over ^
- Class 14. Ridden Coloured Includes Dun, Palomino, Roan & Spotted ^ -Equifest
- Class 15. Riding Club Pony or Horse There will be a small fence to jump for the riding club pony/horse, snaffle bridles only. ^

Ridden Championship 1st & 2nd Placed ridden competitors, excluding class 10, go forward to Championship.

Winners will get points towards end of year 'overall' trophies.



Qualifiers

- **^ ESUK** This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the $25^{th} 27^{th}$ July 2024. The three highest placed exhibits will qualify in each class.
- **Equifest** This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the $1^{st} 4^{th}$ August 2024. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

STARS Champion of Champions – Open to members only. Points will be accumulated over the season across rings 1 and 4.

Rules

- **Appendix 1 Lead-Rein riders aged 9 years & under must be mounted on a suitable height pony committee authorised.
- **Appendix 2 Lead-Rein showing, ponies not to exceed 127cm (12.2) to gain qualification. All other lead-rein riders must be mounted on a suitable height pony committee authorised.
