Ring 1 - In-hand Showing (commencing 09:30am)

Class 1. Youngstock Horse or pony 3 years & under as of 1st January ** *Equifest Qualifier**

Class 2. Mountain & Moreland Open to all ponies registered with their pure-bred societies ^ *Equifest Qualifier* *ESUK Qualifier*

Class 3. Open Plaited Open to any plaited horse or pony ^

Class 4. Open Cob Open to any cobs, shown hogged or traditional

Class 5. ROR Open to any retrained retired racehorse aged 3 years or over

Class 6. Open Pony or Horse Open to all exhibits

Class 7. Young Handler Open to all handlers under 16 (as of 1st January) and their horse or pony. Members points allocated 10 and under and 11 and over ^

Class 8. Senior Handler Open to all handlers 16 and over (as of 1st January) and their horse or pony

Class 9. Veteran Open to any horse or pony aged 15 years or older (as of 1^{st} January) $^{\sim}$

Class 10. Coloured Open to any coloured horse or pony hogged, traditional or plaited including Palomino, Dun, Roan and spotted * *Equifest Qualifier*

In-hand Championship, 1st and 2nd placed competitors from classes 1-10 go forward to the championship

- Ring 2 Ridden Showing (commencing 10:30am)
- **Class 11. Lead Rein** 9 years and under, snaffle bridles only. Ponies do not exceed 127cm (12.2) to gain qualification. Leid-Rein riders must be mounted on a suitable pony height- committee authorised ^ *Equifest Qualifier*
- Class 12. First ridden Rider 12 years and under, pony not to exceed 13.2hh ^ *Equifest Qualifier*
- **Class 13. New, Nervous or Novice** *Individual show piece, no go round, canter optional. Competitors will be invited to the ring collectively for placing*
- **Class 14. Ridden coloured** Open to any coloured horse or pony, hogged, traditional or plaited. Includes Dun, Palomino, Roan and spotted ^ *Equifest Qualifier*
- Class 15. Ridden Veteran Open to any horse or pony 15yrs of age or over (as of 1st January) ^~
- **Class 16. Open Mountain & Moreland** Open to all ponies registered with their pure-bred societies ^ *Equifest Qualifier*
- Class 17. Ridden Plaited Open to any plaited horse or pony
- Class 18. Ridden Cob Open to any cobs, shown hogged or traditional
- Class 19. Ridden ROR Open to any retrained retired racehorses aged 4 years or over

Ridden Championship, 1st and 2nd placed ridden competitors, excluding class 13, go forward to the championship

- Class 20. Leid-Rein Rider 9 years and under
- Class 21. 10 Years and under Fences approximately 50cm
- Class 22. Fences 50cm Juniors Riders aged 16 and under
- Class 23. Fences 50cm Seniors Riders aged 17 and over
- Class 24. Fences 50cm Pairs Any age combination
- Class 25. Fences 60cm approximately Juniors Riders aged 16 and under ^
- Class 26. Fences 60cm approximately Seniors Riders aged 17 and over ^
- Class 27. Fences 70cm approximately Juniors Riders aged 16 and under ^
- Class 28. Fences 70cm approximately Seniors Riders aged 17 and over ^
- Class 29. Fences 80cm approximately Juniors Riders aged 16 and under ^
- Class 30. Fences 80cm approximately Seniors Riders aged 17 and over ^

Ring 4 – Working Hunter (commencing 11:30 am)

Open to both Horses and Ponies. Entry into the showing element where jumping faults have occurred will be at the judge's discretion. Only riders 16 years and over will be allowed to wear spurs

- **Class 31. Riding Club Pony or Horse** There will be a small fence to jump incorporated into a show piece, snaffle bridles only ^
- Class 32. Lead-Rein / Nursery stakes Fences 40cm max Lead Rein entries to be 9 years and under on suitable height pony. Nursery stakes Rider 12 years and under ^
- Class 33. Fences 55cm 65cm approximately ^

Class 34. Fences 65cm - 75cm approximately ^

Class 35. Fences 85cm approximately ^

Working Hunter Championship, 1st and 2nd placed competitors go forward to the championship
